<b>K</b>	<p>Standard(s): VAK.CR.2 Create works of art based on selected themes. VAK.CR.3 Understand and apply media, techniques, and processes of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can use my creativity to create a winter inspired painting using elements of art such as space.</p> <p>SC: I can use the elements of art to create space in my painting and shape with my art piece.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Giant Holiday Lights. .Teacher will guide students by showing how to draw the shape of a single string light on a 12x18 white paper. Students observe that the teacher is using the whole space of the paper to create the bulb shape. Vocabulary - Elements of Art, shape, space, painting.</p>
<b>1st</b>	<p>Standard(s): VA1.CR.2 Create works of art based on selected themes. VA1.CR.3 Understand and apply media, techniques, and processes of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can create a landscape with winter inspired scenery and trees.</p> <p>SC: I can create art that shows the elements of art in shapes and the landscape. I can define landscape.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Winter Landscape. Students will use the elements of art to create triangle trees. May use rulers to make 5 different triangles on paper. They will glue tissue paper onto triangles to make evergreen trees. Teacher will observe student progress by walking around and helping out if students struggle. Day 2 - create collage with white snowy landscape on black paper. Also, create snow with watered down tempera paint. . *Rubric -Teacher will demonstrate how to add tissue paper in pattern to create visually pleasing art. Teacher will demo landscape and process of applying snow to art. Vocabulary - landscape, collage, shapes, elements of art, background, foreground, middle ground.</p>

VA2.CR.3 Understand and apply media, techniques, and processes of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can use elements of art and principles of design to create holiday inspired oil pastel art.</p> <p>SC: I can use shapes and value to create my string light art.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Holiday String Lights. Students will use oil pastels to create value in string lights. Students can draw or trace lights and cut and paste to their art piece.. *Rubric Teacher will observe value and shapes in student work... Vocabulary - oil pastel, value, shapes, collage</p>
<b>3rd</b>	<p>Standard(s): VA3.CR.2 Create works of art based on selected themes. VA3.CR.3 Understand and apply media, techniques, processes, and concepts of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can create a masterpiece using the elements of art. I can paint a watercolor snow globe and add a cityscape into my artwork.</p> <p>SC: I can utilize elements of art such as space, color, texture. I can use different watercolor techniques to add value to my artwork.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Glittery Cityscape Snowglobes. Video demo of watercolor techniques and teacher demo of creating cityscapes. Students will paint a landscape watercolor painting of the inside image of a snowglobe using a warm or cool color scheme. They will add a cityscape using a different color scheme &amp; make their cities appear 3D. *Rubric Teacher will walk around and observe students paintings to make sure they are creating the warm or cool backgrounds and observing the space and 3D techniques in the cityscapes. Peer students or teacher will help struggling students on a one on one basis. Vocabulary - Elements of art, space, landscape, cityscape, collage, watercolor, wet on wet technique, rough sketch</p>

	<p>apply media, techniques, processes, and concepts of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can create a unique masterpiece using a variety of media - oil pastels, fiber. I can create a collage to make my art more interesting.</p> <p>SC: I can create a winter scene using oil pastels to add value in my art. I can create a collage with my string lights to add interest.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Winter String Lights. Students will either trace or free draw 5 or 6 string lights using oil pastels with directed demo drawing. Students will use oil pastels to fill in bulbs with colors. Students will glue a string of yarn across paper for the string. Next they will cut out their lights and glue them to the string. *Rubric - Teacher will observe techniques students use focusing on keeping art pieces tidy and rubbing the edges once glued on. Vocabulary - collage, oil pastels, shapes, colors</p>
<b>5th</b>	<p>Standard(s): VA5.CR.2 Create works of art based on selected themes. VA5.CR.3 Understand and apply media, techniques, processes, and concepts of two-dimensional art.</p> <p>LT: I can create a masterpiece with a landscape scene. I can refine my paintings with a variety of media - pencil, sharpie, watercolors.</p> <p>SC: I can utilize background, middle ground, &amp; foreground in my landscape. I can use watercolor techniques, such as bleeding to add texture to my masterpiece.</p> <p>Lesson/Activity: Students will look at the artwork of artist &amp; graphic designer Jen Aranyi &amp; will create a watercolor and landscape similar to the techniques she uses in her works. Students will use lines to create shadows for value &amp; tone in their art. *Rubric -Teacher will walk around and observe the lines and details in students art. Teacher will demo for struggling students and show them how to add the details to create the value &amp; tone. Vocabulary - landscape, watercolor, bleeding, shadows, detail, value, tone. Diagonal lines.</p>
